

Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board
Regular Meeting
December 18, 2012, 6:30 p.m.

Chairman Donaldson called the meeting to order in the Sheriff's Office Training Center and asked Mr. Martin to give the invocation.

Board members present were Mr. Donaldson, Mr. Martin, Mr. Morris, Mr. Brasher, Mr. Weatherford, and secretary Lucy Womac. Guests present were Sheriff Chris Curry; Chief Deputy John Samaniego; Captains Ken Burchfield, Chris Corbell, and Jay Fondren; and Deputy Nathan Kendrick.

The agenda for the evening was accepted with no changes and included no old business.

Mr. Martin moved to approve as written the minutes of the November 26 regular meeting. Mr. Brasher seconded the motion and it carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Brasher moved to approve the secretary's time sheets and mileage. Mr. Martin seconded the motion and it passed.

Deputy Kendrick had requested an educational incentive of fifteen percent. The Board considered his official transcript from Faulkner University showing he completed a master's of science degree in justice administration. Mr. Morris moved to approve the incentive. Mr. Weatherford seconded the motion and it carried.

A special meeting was called for 5:30 p.m. December 27 in Pelham to discuss the budget. The date of the January regular meeting was changed to the 24th, still 6:30 p.m. at the Training Center.

Sheriff Curry was recognized and gave a PowerPoint presentation to the Board, showing that the agency's budget has not kept up with needs for service. He also said an article written by a Harvard professor recommended investing in education and public safety as the best ways to grow a county.

As FYI, the Board was given a letter saying eight employees' step raises had been approved and signed by Sheriff Curry, as well as the year-to-date monthly budget report for November.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned on motion of Mr. Martin.
