

**Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board**  
**Regular Meeting**  
**March 19, 2013, 6:30 p.m.**

Chairman Donaldson called the monthly meeting to order in the Sheriff's Office Training Center and asked Mr. Weatherford to give the invocation.

Board members and staff present were Mr. Donaldson, Mr. Brasher, Mr. Martin, Mr. Weatherford, Mr. Morris, and secretary Lucy Womac. Guest present was Chief Deputy John Samaniego.

There was no old business to consider on the agenda.

Mr. Martin moved to approve the minutes of the February 19 regular meeting and the March 5 special meeting. Mr. Brasher seconded the motion and it carried.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Mr. Weatherford moved to approve the secretary's time sheets and mileage. Mr. Brasher seconded the motion and it passed.

Applicant Dexter K. Carden had submitted a copy of his orders from the U. S. Navy Reserves. He has weekend drill April 6 (when the Sheriff's Office has the fitness test scheduled) and will be activated on April 19. His written request was to remain on the Corrections Officer list of eligibles for the usual year, plus the length of time he is deployed. Mr. Carden took the February 2 written exam for C. O. Those test results were approved February 19, so Mr. Carden will have been on the certified list of eligibles for two months by the time he is activated. The Board considered minutes from the February 22, 2005 regular meeting when applicant James Phillip Leach's request was granted to remain on the Deputy and C. O. lists during his deployment. Mr. Weatherford now moved to keep Mr. Carden on the C. O. list as per the precedent set in 2005. Mr. Morris seconded the motion and it carried. Mr. Martin noticed that the February 22, 2005 minutes showed former Board member Mickey Johnson made the motion to allow Mr. Leach to remain on the lists, and Mr. Johnson had been inadvertently omitted from the first paragraph naming those in attendance. The members agreed the first paragraph of those minutes should be corrected to include Mr. Johnson as being present.

There was a brief discussion concerning budget matters. The secretary was asked to check on the status of the Bradley Arant account and report back.

Mr. Martin moved to go into executive session at 6:41 p.m. Mr. Brasher seconded the motion and it passed. Mr. Martin moved to come out of executive session at 7:02 p.m. Mr. Weatherford seconded the motion and it carried.

Chairman Donaldson called a special meeting at 5 p.m. Tuesday, April 2, pending availability of a conference room at the County Services Building in Pelham, to discuss the budget. The date of the next regular meeting was moved to Thursday, April 25, still 6:30 p.m. at the Sheriff's Office Training Center.

The Board was given a recent FYI letter of an employee's suspension, and the LEPB's monthly budget printout for February from the County Commission.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned by motion of Mr. Weatherford.
