

Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board
Special Meeting
May 7, 2013, 5:00 p.m.

The main purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the job descriptions and pending salary survey.

Chairman Donaldson called the meeting to order at the County Services Building in Pelham, asking Mr. Morris to give the invocation.

Board members and staff present were Mr. Donaldson, Mr. Weatherford, Mr. Martin, Mr. Brasher, Mr. Morris, and secretary Lucy Womac. Guests present were Chief Deputy John Samaniego and Capt. Chris George.

Chairman Donaldson presented the Board with updated LEPB budget figures. The members agreed to proceed with a salary survey as the budget allows. Chief Samaniego gave the Board a list of items that Sheriff Curry requested to be considered for the survey for implementation in the FY2014 budget year (attached). Mr. Donaldson volunteered to put together an outline, listing options, time frame, expectations, and delivery date, to be used to gather information.
