

Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board
Special Meeting
November 5, 2015, 5:00 p.m.

The main purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the budget and future AUM projects.

Chairman Donaldson called the meeting to order in the County Services Building, asking Mr. Brasher to give the invocation.

Board members and staff present were Mr. Donaldson, Mr. Lewis, Mr. Martin, Mr. Mitchell, Mr. Brasher, and secretary Lucy Womac. Guests present were Sheriff John Samaniego and Chief Deputy Chris George.

Chief George had emailed a request for a new Admin/Clerical/Support Services exam, last given in December, 2011. Sheriff Samaniego informed the Board members that a records clerk plans to retire next spring and they would like for the Board to have the exam administered after the first of the year. For the subsequent typing test, he suggested the Training Center's computer lab, which has twenty-four work stations available. Mr. Lewis moved to start the testing process. Mr. Mitchell seconded the motion and it carried.

The LEPB's budget and future AUM projects were discussed. The secretary was asked to find out when the Board's annual allotment went to its current level. Mr. Martin requested removing the Sheriff as a contact person on the Memorandum of Agreement, as the Sheriff's Office will have input when the Rules are rewritten. Mr. Mitchell moved to accept the proposal with that change. Mr. Lewis seconded the motion and it passed.

The December regular meeting was changed to Monday the 7th, pending availability of the Training Center's conference room. With no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
