

Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board
Work Session
December 16, 2015, 4:00 p.m.

The purpose of the work session was to discuss budget planning and proposed projects with AUM's Center for Business for the coming fiscal year.

Chairman Donaldson called the meeting to order in the County Services Building, asking Mr. Martin to give the invocation.

Board members and staff present were Mr. Donaldson, Mr. Martin, Mr. Mitchell, Mr. Lewis, and secretary Lucy Womac. Guest present was Chief Deputy Chris George.

Mr. Donaldson led a discussion concerning the Board's current budget figures, and how the planned Rules rewrite and future promotional and entry-level open testing processes will impact the budget. AUM's proposal dated October 29, 2014 included testing for Corrections Sergeant, sworn Law Enforcement Sergeant and Lieutenant, and rewriting the Board's Rules. The testing/assessment process for Corrections Sergeant was implemented earlier this year. Two copies of a contract to rewrite the Rules and Regulations were recently signed by Chairman Donaldson and forwarded to AUM for the Chancellor's signature. The rewrite will be completed in 2016.

The secretary was asked to contact AUM to request a new proposal that would include promotional testing for sworn Law Enforcement Sergeant and Lieutenant in 2016, enacted as soon as possible.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
