

**Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board**  
**Regular Meeting**  
**May 17, 2016, 6:30 p.m.**

Secretary of the Board Bill Martin called the meeting to order at the Sheriff's Office Training Center.

Board members present were Mr. Martin, Mr. Brasher, and Mr. Mitchell. The guest present was Chief Deputy Chris George. Each attendee in turn offered an invocation.

The LEPB's last budget information from Commission Accounting was distributed. The budget and AUM projects were tabled for a future meeting.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Mr. Mitchell moved that the secretary's time sheets and mileage for the month be approved as submitted. Mr. Brasher seconded the motion and it passed.

New Corrections Officer Matthew Mosley had emailed a request for the Board to consider whether psychology or forensic psychology would qualify for an educational incentive of fifteen percent. He plans to pursue a master's degree at American Military University where he obtained his bachelor's degree. The matter was tabled until the next meeting.

The Board was presented the results of the written exams for Deputy and Corrections Officer held on May 7. Mr. Mitchell moved to approve the new lists of eligibles. Mr. Brasher seconded the motion and it carried. Chief George was given copies of the lists.

Mr. Mitchell moved to approve AUM's invoice for \$5,395.07, and Jan Walker's bill for \$257.72 to administer the recent exams. Mr. Brasher seconded the motion and it passed. A bill for IPMA membership dues for \$393.00 was tabled.

As FYI, the Sheriff had approved twelve employees' step raises due in June, with one being denied due to a suspension.

At the April meeting, a planning session was called for 5:00 p.m. May 23<sup>rd</sup> in Pelham.
