

Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board
Special Emergency Meeting
February 11, 2016, 5:00 p.m.

The purpose of the special emergency meeting was to consider an employee's request to use time from the Reserve Sick Leave Bank.

Chairman Donaldson called the meeting to order in the County Services Building, asking Mr. Martin to give the invocation.

Board members and staff present were Mr. Donaldson, Mr. Lewis, Mr. Brasher, Mr. Martin, and secretary Lucy Womac. Guests present were Sheriff John Samaniego and Chief Deputy Chris George.

A Deputy had requested up to thirty days from the Reserve Sick Leave Bank. According to the RSLB policy, all other types of leave time must be depleted before time from the Bank is used. The Board considered the employee's FLMA paperwork showing the doctor's diagnosis. With no other leave time available to cover the pay period ending today, Mr. Lewis moved to grant the request. Mr. Brasher seconded the motion and it carried. Payroll had been informed of the meeting's purpose and will be apprised of the approval. Chairman Donaldson suggested that a request for thirty more days be submitted for consideration at the regular meeting the following week.
