

Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board
Special Meeting
July 7, 2016, 4:00 p.m.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss Chief Deputy Chris George's recommended changes to the LEPB Rules, written per the Board's request and approved by the Sheriff. AUM SummaSource will conduct the final edit before Board approval.

Chairman Donaldson called the meeting to order in the County Services Building, asking Mr. Brasher to give the invocation.

Board members and staff present were Mr. Donaldson, Mr. Lewis, Mr. Brasher, Mr. Mitchell, Mr. Martin, and secretary Lucy Womac. Guest present was Chief George.

The Board had been given copies of the Rules with suggested changes. At the front was a letter from the Chief stating the reason for each change. He reiterated points throughout the first sections of the Rules including fitness testing, incentives, classifications, and pay rates, and expounded on these during discussion.

All present agreed that because the LEPB's Rules are complicated and frequently updated, more time should be spent reviewing the suggestions. At their regular meeting of July 11, the Board members will decide when to meet again to discuss more changes to the Rules.
