

Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board
Special Meeting
October 3, 2016, 4:00 p.m.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the proposed changes to the Reserve Sick Leave Bank request form and the LEPB Rules and Regulations.

Secretary of the Board Bill Martin called the meeting to order in the County Services Building in Pelham and asked Mr. Brasher to give the invocation.

Board members and staff present were Mr. Martin, Mr. Brasher, Mr. Lewis, and secretary Lucy Womac. Guest present was Sheriff John Samaniego.

With input from members unable to attend, those present agreed that the October 18 regular meeting should be moved to Monday, October 17. The secretary reported that the conference room in the Butch Ellis Building is available to the LEPB on Oct. 17.

The Board considered the suggested changes to the RSLB request form and the Rules previously distributed. Mr. Lewis moved to allow the proposed Rule changes to be presented to the rank and file at a future LEPB meeting. Mr. Brasher seconded the motion and it carried. Mr. Lewis then moved to accept the new wording for the RSLB form to request days from the Bank. All mention of the Family Medical Leave Act, a separate appendix to the Rules, had been removed from the RSLB information. Mr. Brasher seconded, and the motion passed. Approved by the Board, the proposed changes will now be presented to the employees for their input. If the LEPB adopts the RSLB policy and its forms to participate in and to request days, and the other proposed Rule changes, the RSLB would be added as an appendix to the Rules.

Also discussed was the Board's latest fiscal year budget information from Commission Accounting. With no further business, the meeting was adjourned on motion of Mr. Lewis.
