

Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board
Special Meeting
May 30, 2017, 4:30 p.m.

The purposes of the special meeting were to consider a request for Reserve Sick Leave Bank time, to approve the Captain assessment results from Industrial/Organizational Solutions, and to discuss agenda items tabled from the May 16 regular meeting.
