

Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board
Work Session
August 15, 2017, 5:00 p.m.

The purpose of the work session was to review the proposed Rules. Chairman Donaldson called the meeting to order at the Sheriff's Office Training Center, asking Mr. Martin to give the invocation.

Board members and staff present were Mr. Donaldson, Mr. Mitchell, Mr. Martin, Mr. Brasher, and secretary Lucy Womac. Guests present were Chief Deputy Chris George and Mr. Brasher's nephew Ricky Brasher.

Mr. Donaldson had highlighted parts of the Rules he felt needed updating. The appendices to be attached were confirmed; the rest would be linked to other websites. After a lengthy discussion, Chief George reviewed the items to be changed and the appendices, and said he could have the updates available the next day for the Board's perusal.

Chief Deputy Chris George showed the Board members a short video to the work session that could be run at theaters before the main features. The infomercials would cost \$1,500 to \$1,800 each. The members agreed that the Board would share in marketing costs.

After speaking with Board member Chris Lewis via conference call, Chairman Donaldson called a special meeting for 4 p.m. Tuesday, September 5 to discuss the Rules, exam scores, and advertising, pending availability of a conference room in Pelham.
