

Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board

The purposes of the special meeting were to tour the LEPB office and to discuss and vote on unfinished business.

The Board members toured the office and discussed the new furniture and files. Chairman Donaldson called the meeting to order. Arnold participated during the executive session via conference call.
