 - a) May and June Budget reports were reviewed, no action was necessary.

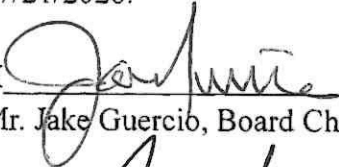

RECESS/ADJOURN

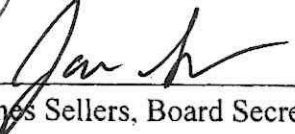
There being no further business, Mr. Bill Keller made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Alan Miller. The motion passed unanimously.
